Bachelor in Economic and Business Sciences by the Complutense University of Madrid, Carlos Aníbarro Martín is Accounts Auditor, registered in the R.O.A.C (I.C.A.C.), from the Ministry of Economy and Competitiveness and belongs to the Technical Auditing and Accounting Body.

After occupying several posts in the Internal Revenue administration he passed onto the IGAE, where he was Financial Control Auditor over Autonomous organisms, Audit Supervisor and Accounting Service Chief. In 1988, he was Chief Auditor and Technical Counselor for the economic-accounting area of the Accounting and Accounts Audit Institute (ICAC).

In 1991, he started to develop his activity in several public companies, assuming the posts of Financial Director in the Cartuja Society 93 and in State Society for International Exhibits, S.A. (S.E.E.I.), among others.

In the academic arena, he was professor for Financial Management in the Financial Studies Centre (CEF). Likewise he has been a member of the Work Group that elaborated the norms for the adaptation of the General Accounting Plan for Sport Federations and a member of the Public service Examinations Tribunal for entry in the Management Body of the Internal Revenue. He has authored the book "Practical Financial Management Manual in the Public Administration and its Autonomous Bodies" edited by CEF.
